TERMS DEFINITIONS Port -Liquefied Natural Gas MAIB -**Elementary First Aid** MCA -Tanker Fire Fighting In charge of engineer department and upkeep of engineering systems Seafarer -Captain -Holds huge quantities of cargo Chief Engineer -For transiting passengers Container Ships -Carries large amounts of liquid cargo Tanker Ships -Any person who is employed or engaged in any capacity on board a ship Passenger Ships -Maritime Accident Investigation Bureau Speciality Vessels -In command of ship, responsible for safety of all crew and the vessel TFF -Constructed and used for specific purposes EFA -Facing forward, anything to the left of the boat LNG -Maritime and Coastguard Agency
